1. Covid-19- general information

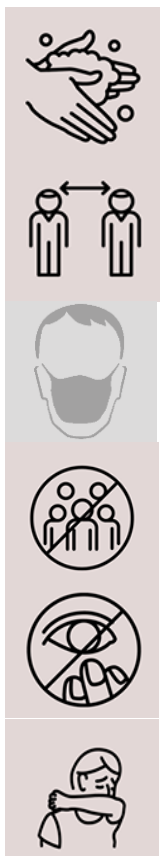
As organizers, we are aware of our responsibility and make every effort to fulfill our social responsibility and to minimize the risk of infection during the event as far as possible. We also ask you as players, team members, press representatives, employees and other people involved to exercise risk-conscious behavior on your own responsibility - on the event site and outside in your privacy.

Symptoms

The COVID-19 virus can have different effects on everyone. Clinical criteria are: Anyone with at least one of the following symptoms: cough, fever, shortness of breath, sudden onset of a disorder, or loss of taste or smell. In addition, less specific symptoms such as headache, muscle pain, body aches, tiredness, vomiting or diarrhea can occur.

If you have symptoms or are afraid of being ill, the general rule is: stay at home, avoid contact with other people, call health hotline 1450 and please follow the advice carefully. For all participants and employees of the event, this means that the event CAN NOT BE VISITED.

General preventive measures



Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly with warm water and soap (at least 30 seconds washing time is recommended). Disinfectants should be used regularly.

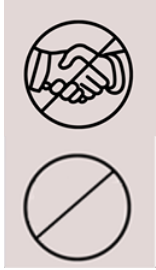
Keep Distance. At least 2 m to all other people.

Wear your FFP2-mask.

Avoid crowds.

Do not touch your eyes, nose and mouth! Hands can pick up viruses and spread the virus on the face.

Pay attention to respiratory hygiene! When coughing or sneezing, keep your mouth and nose covered with a bent elbow or a handkerchief and throw it away immediately.



Do not shake hands.

If there are any signs of illness or suspected infection, please stay at home!

2. Accreditation – access to the event venue

The event area may ONLY be entered by persons who have been officially accredited IN ADVANCE. Audiences / visitors are NOT allowed at the event.

For press representatives

Accreditation must be requested in advance. Markus Hammer, presse@beachvolleyball-baden.at .

For athletic and medical staff, other employees

Everyone who is officially assigned to work at the site is automatically accredited. The accreditation is carried out daily. There is no access to the premises on non-duty days.

Opening Hours

The event venue is open on the first weekend (Continental Cup) from Wednesday to Sunday from 6:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. or until the end of the last match. On the second weekend (U22 EM) daily from 7:00 a.m. An official accreditation and a negative test result (see point 3) are absolutely necessary. Players and supervisors can also enter the grounds for trainings on Monday and Tuesday at their own risk. However, trainings must be registered with Jasmin Schlägner, jasmin.schlaegner@hotmail.com.

3. Covid-19 tests

The site may only be entered with a negative Covid-19 test report. The negative test result is checked daily before entering the event venue!

All employees, sports and medical staff, press representatives and all other participants must present a negative Covid-19 notification before entering the site. This can be a PCR test OR an antigen test. The result must not date back more than 48 hours (from the time the sample was taken). The test result must include the name of the person tested, the date and time of sampling and a QR code or, alternatively, the signature and stamp of the body performing the test. A self-test is not sufficient.

Since the test result must not be older than 48 hours, a new test must be carried out every second day at the latest and the test report must be carried with you every day and presented at Check-In.

Antigen testing facilities

The easiest and fastest antigen test option (without making an appointment) is the sports hall (HalleB), Waltersdorferstrasse 40, 2500 Baden. The test center is available for free antigen tests during the following times:

Monday: 7 a.m. - 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Wednesday: 7 a.m. - 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Friday: 7 a.m. - 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Saturday: 8 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Other test lanes in the region, pharmacies and doctors also offer antigen test facilities.

For people staying in the at the park Hotel, there are also test options directly in the hotel on the following days:

Wednesday 5th May., 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Thursday 6th May, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Wednesday 12th May, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

For people who are staying in the Schloss / Hotel Weikersdorf, there are also test options directly in the hotel on the following days:

Wednesday, May 12th, 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

4. Mask requirement

All persons over the age of 14 must wear an FFP2 mask on the entire event site. Please ensure the correct fit and correct handling and change the masks when they are wet.

Exceptions

There is no need to wear masks when eating or drinking and the people who are involved in sports directly on the field (players, referees). For representatives of the press a mask is also required on the field.

For (ball) children between 6 and 14 years of age, there is no FFP2 mask requirement, but please wear regular mouth and nose protection.

5. Regulations if a SARS-CoV-2 infection occurs

If there is a suspected case, someone shows symptoms etc., please immediately separate the person concerned from all other people.
